The full Town Report and Warrant must be mailed no later than Tuesday, May 13.
- B. Moratorium Petition: Claudia said lawyers have told her this citizens' petition is invalid, and must not be discussed at all at Town Meeting. Vagueness about the requirement to comply with the comprehensive plan of 1991 was cited as the principal reason, since the comprehensive plan was amended in 2002-2003. Stuart said that Erik Stumpf of Eaton Peabody had told Edgcomb a moratorium can be retroactive, for as long as one or two years. He will call Sue Pilgrim at MMA to clarify this.

- A. General Assistance: Jo said she had granted \$89.00 of gasoline from the Waldo Dodge fund to an applicant for automobile fuel; bill from Skip Cahill's in To Be Paid file.
