

TOWN OF EDGECOMB
Minutes of the Selectmen's Meeting
August 2, 2010

PRESENT: Jack Sarmanian, Stuart Smith and Jessica Chubbuck, (selectmen); Jennifer Elkins (secretary)

The meeting was called to order at 6:04 p.m.

A motion was made to approve the minutes of the July 19, 2010 meeting as read. Seconded. Passed 3-0.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

John Cote stated that he has been requesting a bottle collection system for one year and five months. Jack French said he will have it next week. Jarryl Larson sought clarification regarding the June 21st Selectmen's meeting: the issue of working on the road had been brought up by the road commissioner, not the contractor. She also inquired who the new Land Use/Consultant developer will be regarding Gateway I, and was told by Jack that the Public Notice for the RFP will be going into papers tomorrow morning.

NEW BUSINESS:

Planning Board Alternate

Jack French recommended the appointment of Amber Tonry as alternate member of the Planning Board. David Nutt will be appointed upon his return, approximately in 2 ½ months. *A motion was made to approve the above appointments. Seconded. Passed 3-0.*

Stuart presented a list of appointments for all of Edgcomb's various boards. Jack will check with Claudia for those who need to be sworn in, and was informed by Claudia that the individuals need to be called and asked first.

RFP Transportation Land/Use

The Town of Edgcomb, Maine is requesting Transportation/Land Use Planning Services for the Town of Edgcomb to review existing ordinances, modify and/or establish new ordinances, and develop a strategic plan and provide several public hearing/workshops for its citizens to enhance the Gateway I Project covering the Route 1, Davis Island and Route 27 areas.

The work includes hiring a Land Use Planner/Developer for one year. The RFP requests must be returned to Dr. Jack Sarmanian by Friday, August 23, 2010 by 4:00pm. The sealed proposals will be due by September 17th and Jack is expecting to have someone in place around October 1st. The RFP public notice will appear in this week's Kennebec Journal, The Lincoln County News, the Wiscasset Newspaper, and the Boothbay Register.
