I hereby resign my position as a member of the Fort Edgecomb Bicentennial Committee and all planning committees associated.

I joined this committee early this spring to assist with fundraising for the Fort Edgecomb Bicentennial celebration. In light of recent events, I feel that the ability of this committee to move ahead has been irrevocably damaged. I believe that the Board of Selectmen made the right decision to retain possession of the funds raised by this committee, and trust that those funds will be used for the purpose for which they were raised. I will not associate myself as an individual, and community volunteer, with anything potentially viewed as inappropriate or controversial.

This committee acted in good faith, under confusing circumstances that were continually questioned by myself and other committee members. We asked for clarification, which is why a letter was drafted to the Selectmen, in hopes that we could confidently move forward with fundraising.

I am happy to lend whatever assistance is necessary to allow Selectmen to move beyond this situation but, I cannot in good faith, continue my role as a member of this committee. I have also submitted my resignation as a newly appointed member of The Board of Directors to the Friends of Fort Edgecomb effective immediately.
