Before you go online or call to apply, it is helpful to have the following information ready:

- A phone number where you can be reached
- Your Social Security number
- Bank account and routing numbers if you wish to speed up your assistance with direct deposit
- A list of damages and losses you suffered
- Your insurance company and your policy number
