Re: Information & Notice of an upcoming Meeting

This is to advise you that Lincoln County is planning to hold an Informational Meeting in August to explore the possibility of expanding its E-Waste Collection Program into a full Universal Waste Collection Program.

This first Notice is being sent to both Municipal Officers and Transfer Station Officials. When the actual date of the Meeting is set, the information will be provided to the Municipal Officers via e-mail to each Town Office and to Transfer Station Officials at their normal addresses.

We have received a response to our recent survey from sites that serve nine Lincoln County towns and feel there is sufficient interest to hold an Informational Meeting. Ann Pistell from the DEP and Rick Dumas from E-Waste Recycling Solutions (our E-Waste Consolidator) will be present along with County Staff to discuss quantities, storage capabilities and DEP Requirements etc.

If you are a Transfer Station Official receiving this Notice and you have not yet filled out the LINCOLN COUNTY UNIVERSAL WASTE COLLECTION SURVEY sent to you some weeks ago, please do so and forward it to Mike Thompson at the Lincoln County Recycling Department, 54 Huntoon Hill Road, Wiscasset, Maine 04578. We need accurate information in order to determine if we can proceed.
